Nikitas Kaklamanis was born on the Cycladic island of Andros in 1946. He graduated from the University of Athens Medical School in 1971 and specialised in radiotherapy and oncology. In 1981 he received his doctorate from the Athens Medical School and in 1989 was unanimously elected Assistant Professor of Radiotherapy for the School. He has undertaken extensive scientific and research work and is a member of several scientific organisations.

<i>1990</i>	Elected as MP for the New Democracy
<i>1994</i>	Joined the European Parliament, with the Political Spring Party
<i>2000</i>	Elected MP for the Athens A constituency with New Democracy, and worked as "shadow minister" for the party's Health and welfare Section
<i>2001</i>	Elected Parliamentary Coordinator of the party's Standing Committee for Social Affairs
<i>2004</i>	Re-elected MP for the Athens A constituency with New Democracy
<i>March 2004-2006</i>	Named Minister of Health and Social Solidarity
<i>2006-2007</i>	Mayor of Athens

From 1975 to 1989 he was consistently elected to head medical doctors' unions. In 1987 he was elected General Secretary of the Pan Hellenic Medical Association, for a second time, with an unprecedented 93% of the vote.
