

Mayors Adapt fully integrated into the Covenant of Mayors as of February 2017

With the launch of the [Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy](#) on October 15th 2015, the [Mayors Adapt](#) and [Covenant of Mayors](#) Communities joined forces, forming a unique movement of local and regional authorities committed to climate change adaptation and mitigation actions - in line with the EU 2030 framework for climate and energy.

The Mayors Adapt and Covenant of Mayors procedures have been smoothly aligned over the last year - both initiatives will enter into a full merger as of February 2017. From then on, Mayors Adapt signatories will be invited to follow the procedures as described below.

→ Unified Helpdesk and communication channels

Mayors Adapt Signatories will continue receiving **multilingual assistance** from a **unified Covenant of Mayors Helpdesk Team** at info@eumayors.eu.

Information on local adaptation, so far provided through the Mayors Adapt communication and twitter channels, will be fully incorporated into the Covenant of Mayors for Climate & Energy **twitter** account (@eumayors) and **website** (www.eumayors.eu). → Common monitoring and reporting framework

By joining Mayors Adapt, local authorities have formally committed to reporting progress every two years following signing up to the initiative. The Mayors Adapt Monitoring & Reporting Template assists signatories in presenting and structuring their adaptation strategy and action plan, as well as tracking their implementation progress. This Excel-based template must be filled in English. Once completed, it must be submitted via email to info@eumayors.eu - together with the associated documents available (in English and/or national language) (see more information in the [Mayors Adapt Reporting Guidelines](#)). The Adaptation Strategy and/or Action Plan will be published on the Covenant of Mayors website, under your signatory profile. Signatories can specify which other submitted documents (e.g. Risk & Vulnerability Assessment(s)) they wish to make public in the "Actions" tab of the template.

An online template and online submission process will be proposed in the first half of 2017 on the [Covenant of Mayors website](#) to facilitate reporting for local authorities. More information to follow as soon as the system is up and running.

*Note: For Mayors Adapt Signatories due to report in 2016, the deadline for submitting the Adaptation Strategies/Action Plan is **end of January 2017**.
